What is an Approved Occupant?

Am I a "Tenant"?

No, the Tenant/s is listed on the General Tenancy Agreement and you are staying at the property as a guest of the Tenant/s. Therefore any arrangements for rent / bill payments etc. are a private agreement between yourselves and the Tenant/s.

What do I need to provide to be an Approved Occupant?

- This form below to be fully completed
- 100 points of ID to confirm who you are to enable a database check to be carried out
- Payslips if applicable
- <u>Signature from the person appearing on the General Tenancy Agreement as the Tenant/s</u> <u>for the property</u>

Before you move into the rental home, this application must be handed into our office for processing and handed over to the owner for a decision to be made.
