

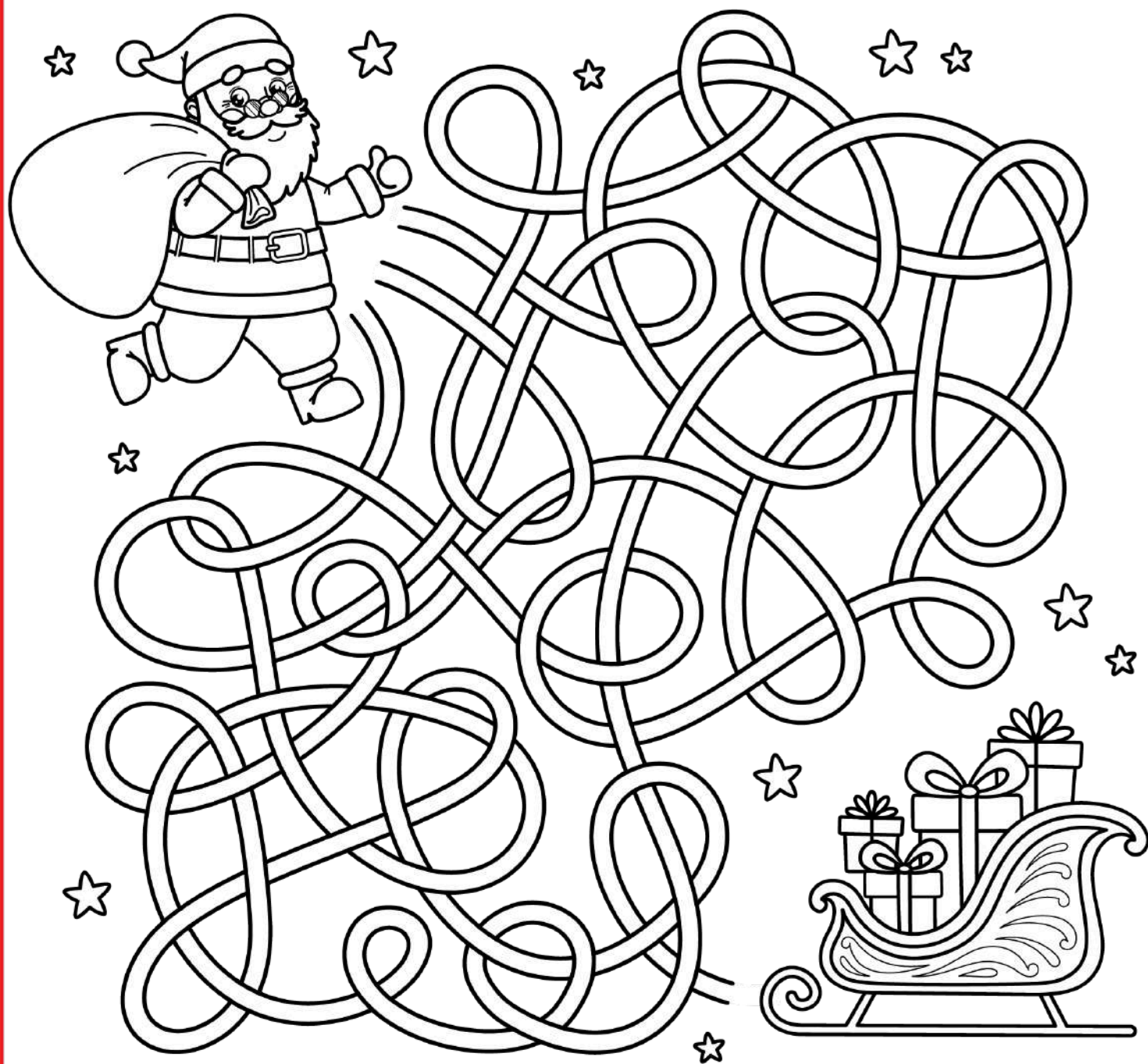

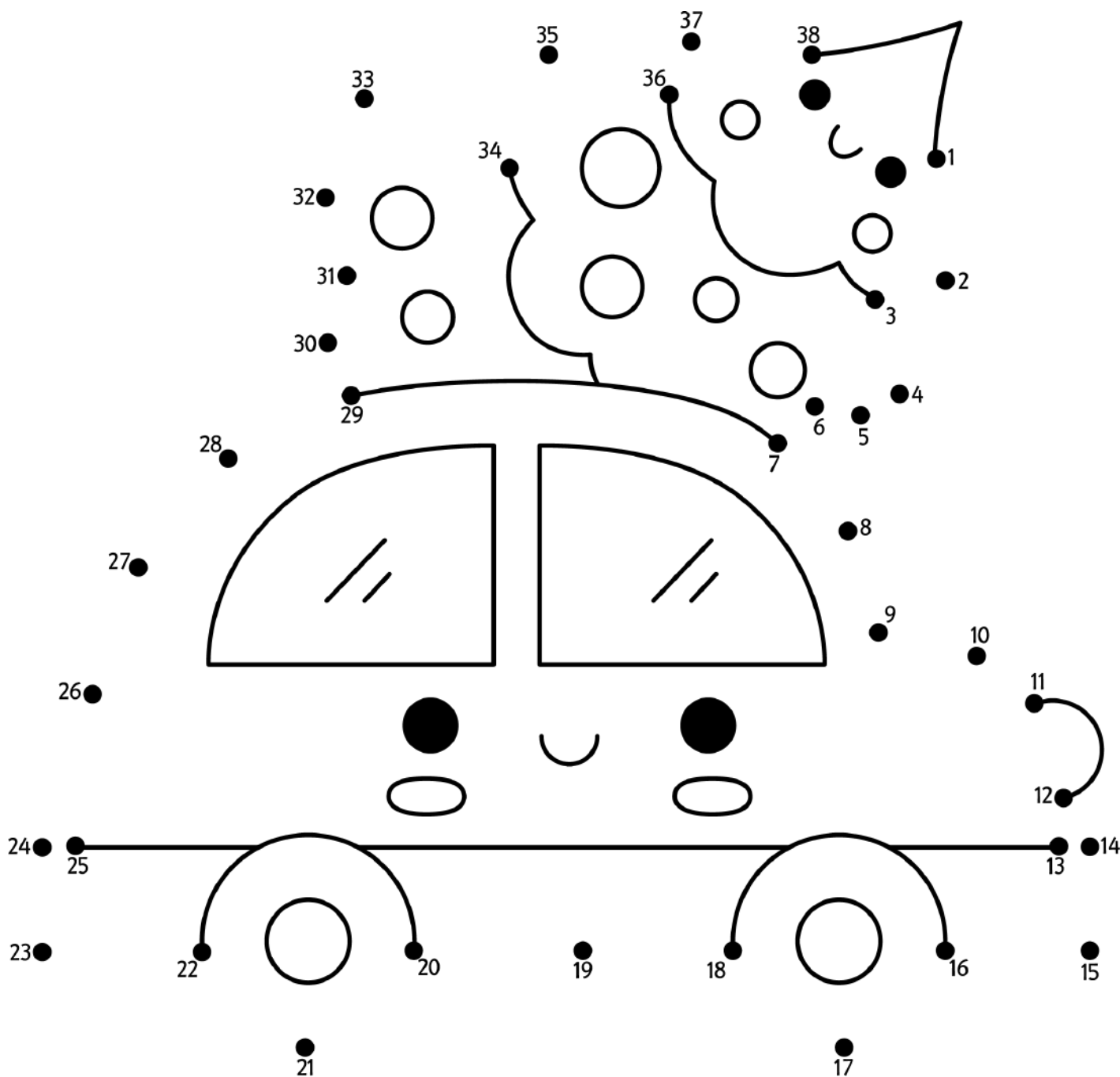

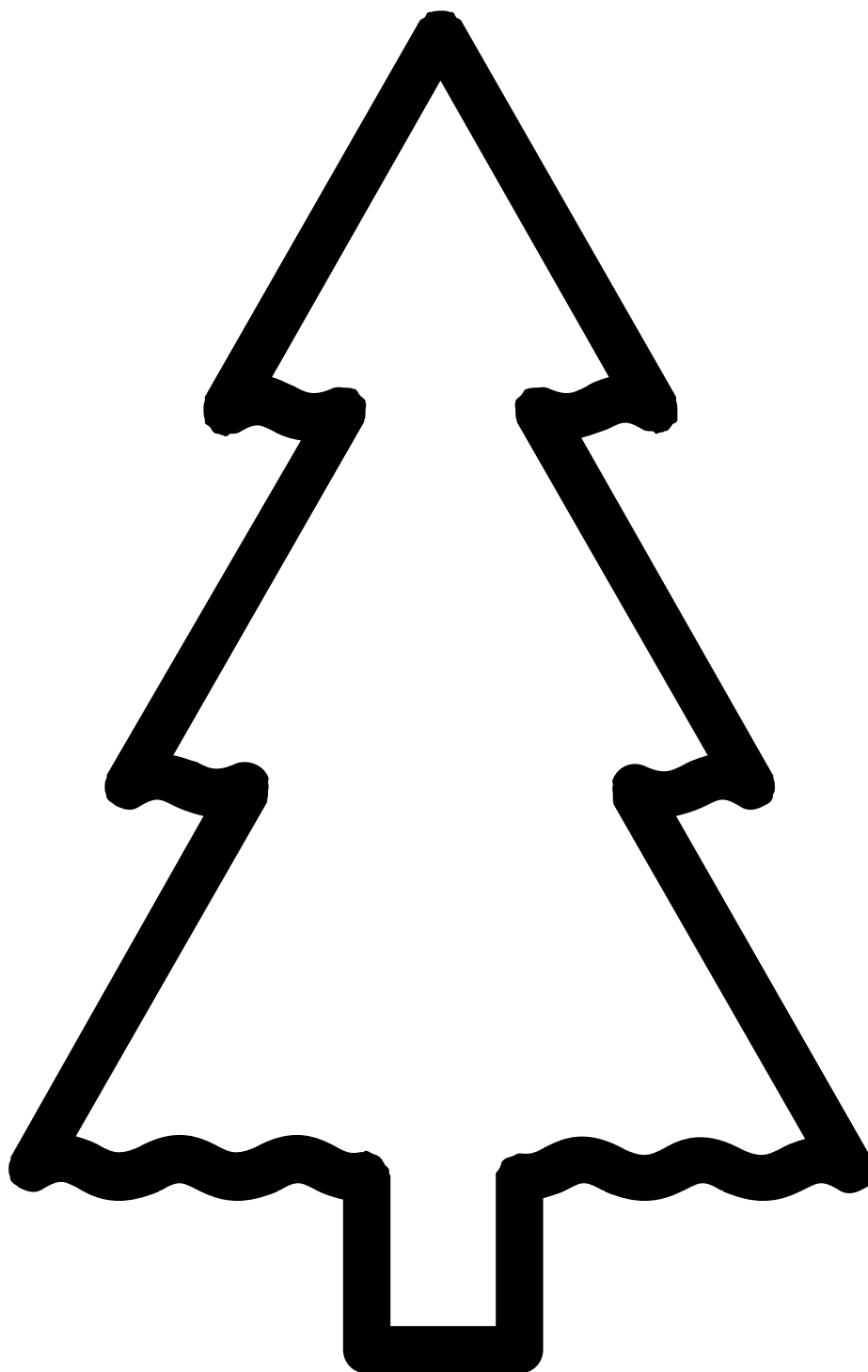
CHRISTMAS BELL SYMMETRY DRAWING

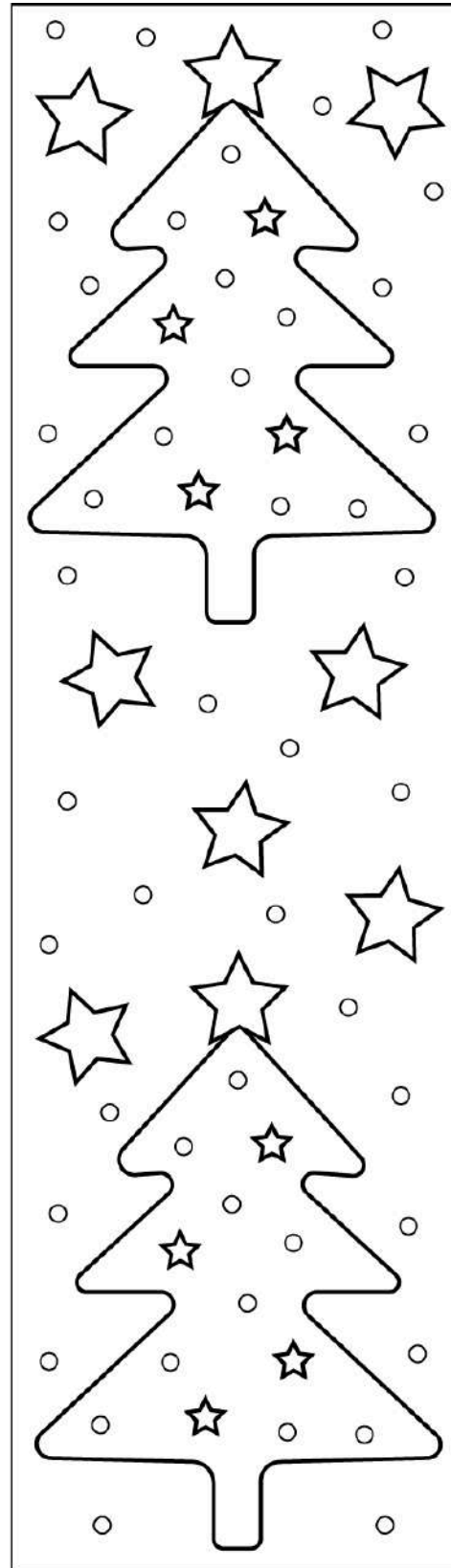
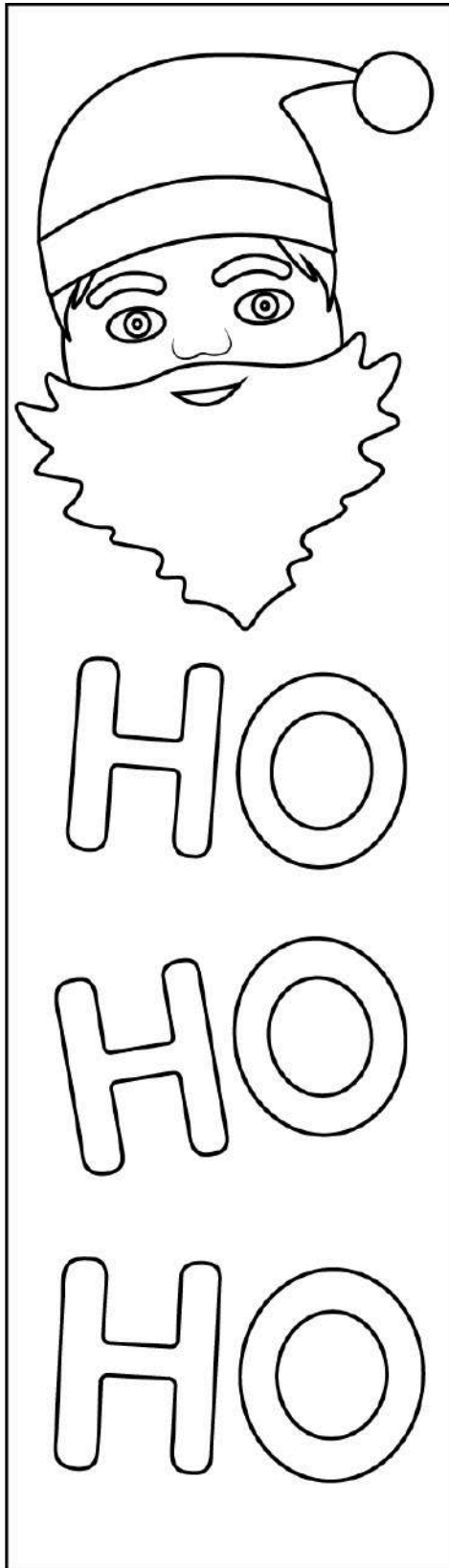

BOW TIE NOODLE WREATH CHRISTMAS CARD



MATERIALS NEEDED

- Mini bow tie noodles
- Green paint
- Paintbrush
- Green glitter
- Red polka dot ribbon or other ribbon of your choosing
- Glue

4 STEPS

1. Start by painting all the little bow tie noodles with green paint.
2. While the paint is still wet, shake with green glitter.
3. Once the noodles are completely dry, glue them into a circle on a piece of white card stock.
4. Tie a bow with a red polka dot ribbon and glue it on the bottom of the wreath!

SCRAP RIBBON CHRISTMAS TREE ORNAMENTS



MATERIALS NEEDED

- Straight sticks (15cm in length)
- Ribbons (cut into approx 23cm strips)
- Hot glue gun
- Twine
- Scissors

5 METHOD STEPS

1. Tie single loose knots down the twig.
2. Bunch the ribbons close together. The ribbons will bend and slightly overlap. Gently tug them into place until you are satisfied with their placement. You will use approximately 13-16 strips of ribbon for each ornament.
3. With the help of a parent, use sharp scissors to trim the ribbon scraps into the shape of a Christmas tree. If desired, melt the edges of the ribbons with a match so the ribbon doesn't fray.
4. Hot glue or tie a loop of twine to the top of the tree.

CANDY CANE NAME ORNAMENT



MATERIALS NEEDED

- red pony beads (but any colour will work)
- Alphabet beads
- White pipe cleaners

5 METHOD STEPS

1. Lay out your design spelling your name with the alphabet beads.
2. Add 1-2 red pony beads between the alphabet beads.
3. Once you like the design, take the pip cleaner and bend the edge of the pipe cleaner to prevent beads slipping off. You may need an adults help with this.
4. Slide the beads of your deisgn onto the pipe cleaner.
5. Once all the beads have been added, bend the opposite end of the pipe cleaner over.
6. Add a slight bend in the pipe cleaner to form the hook of the candy cane.

PAPER BALL REINDEERS

MATERIALS NEEDED

- light brown construction paper
- dark brown construction paper
- scissors
- optional paper trimmer
- glue
- wiggle eye stickers or googly eyes.
Alternatively, you can also draw your own.
- red pom pom or red construction paper

STEPS

1. With the help of an adult, cut 4 paper strips, measuring about a 'finger wide, across the width of an A4 paper.
2. Gently bend the strips in half, then fold marking the middle of the paper strips.
3. Apply a small amount of glue on the middle of the paper strip. Then place another paper strip on top of the first one, centered and at a 90-degree angle.
4. Glue on the other two, evenly spaced.
5. Take one end of one paper strip and apply glue to it.
6. Take the other end of the same paper strip and glue it together with the first end, making a circle loop. Continue with all other paper strips until you have a nice-looking paper ball.
7. Cut antlers out of darker construction paper. Fold them at the bottom end (L shape) and apply glue, sticking them to the top of the paper ball.
8. Take a pom pom, add glue, and press it onto the paper ball.
9. Add two wiggle eye stickers or googly eyes.
