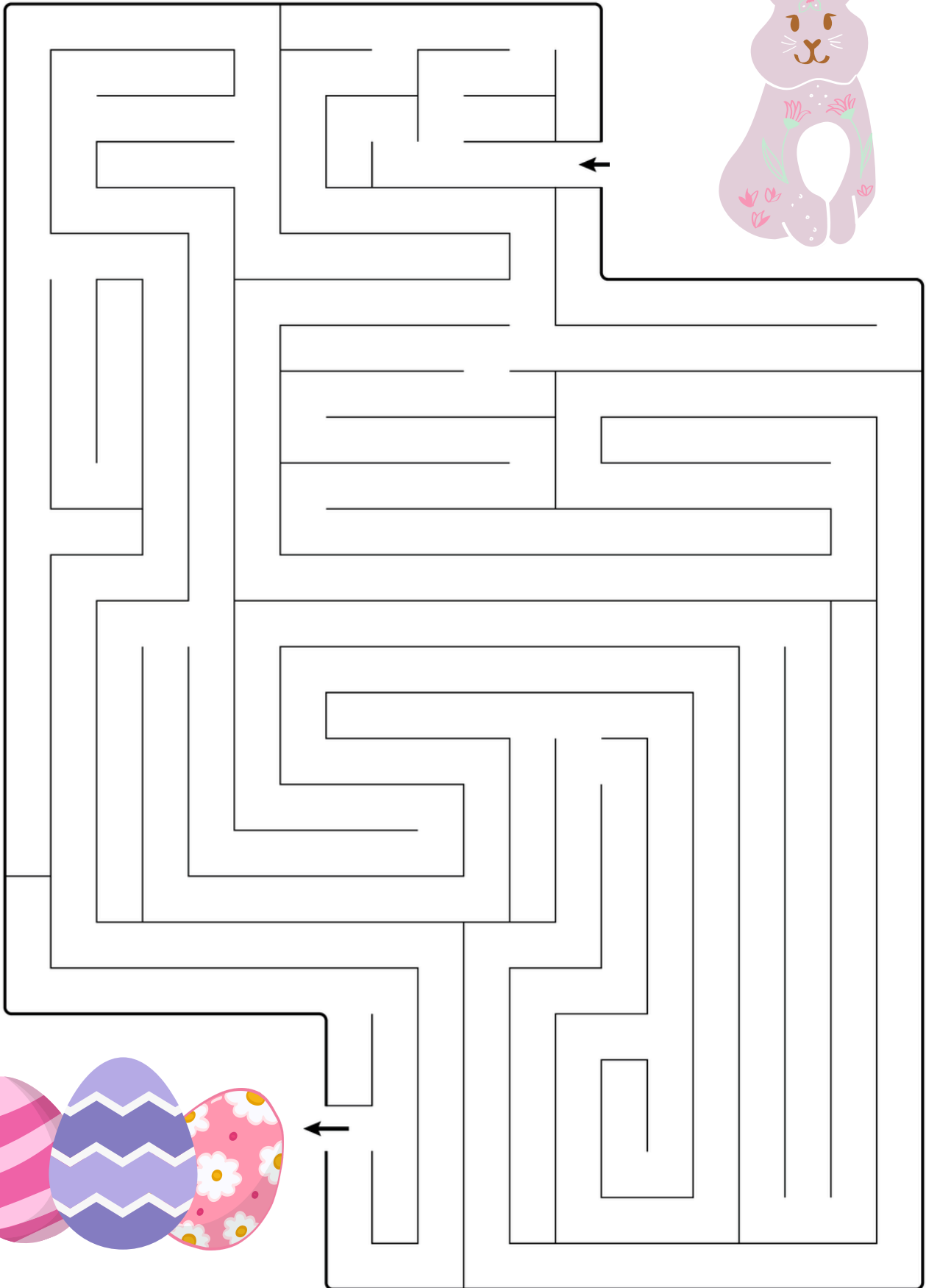

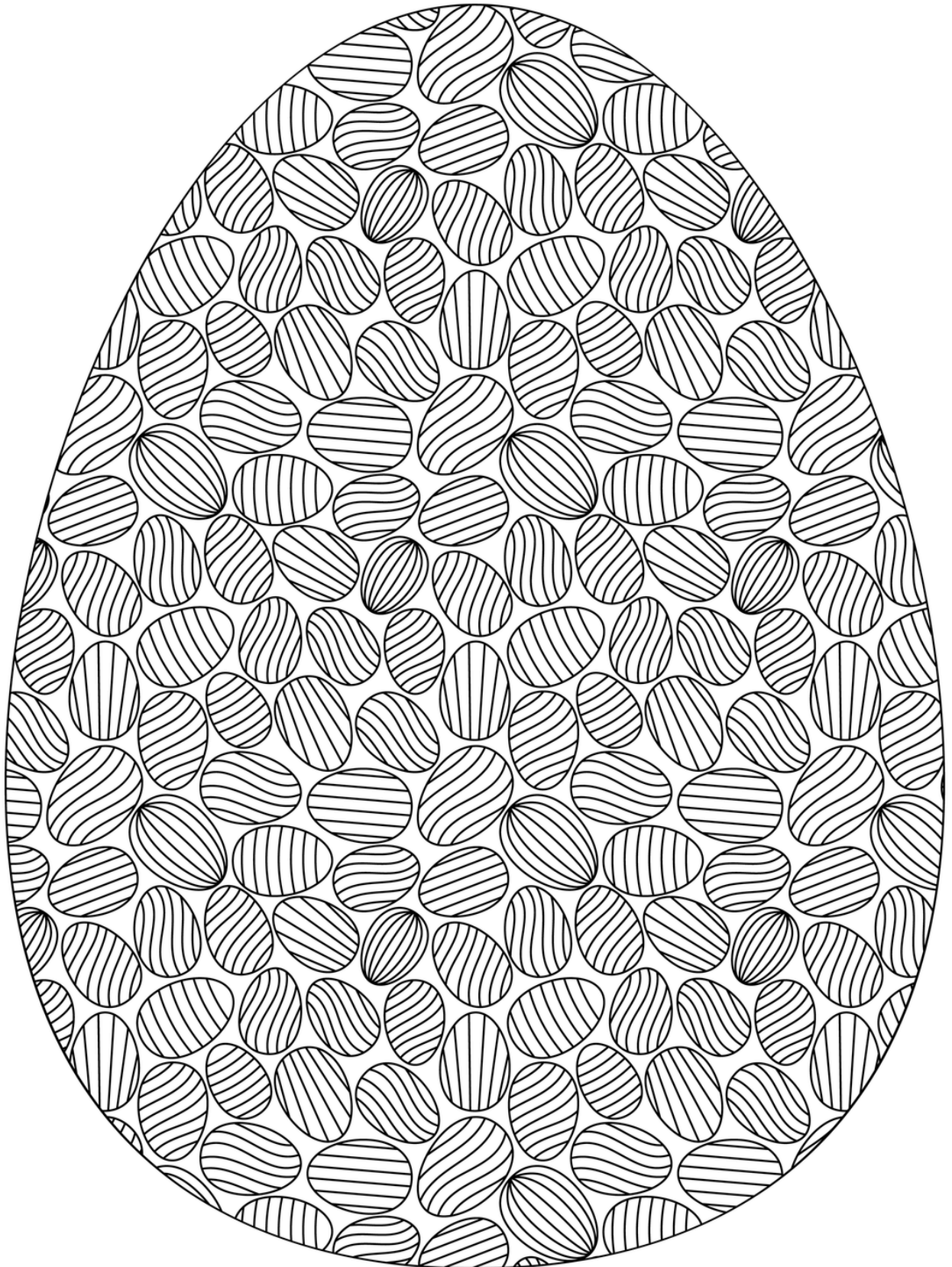

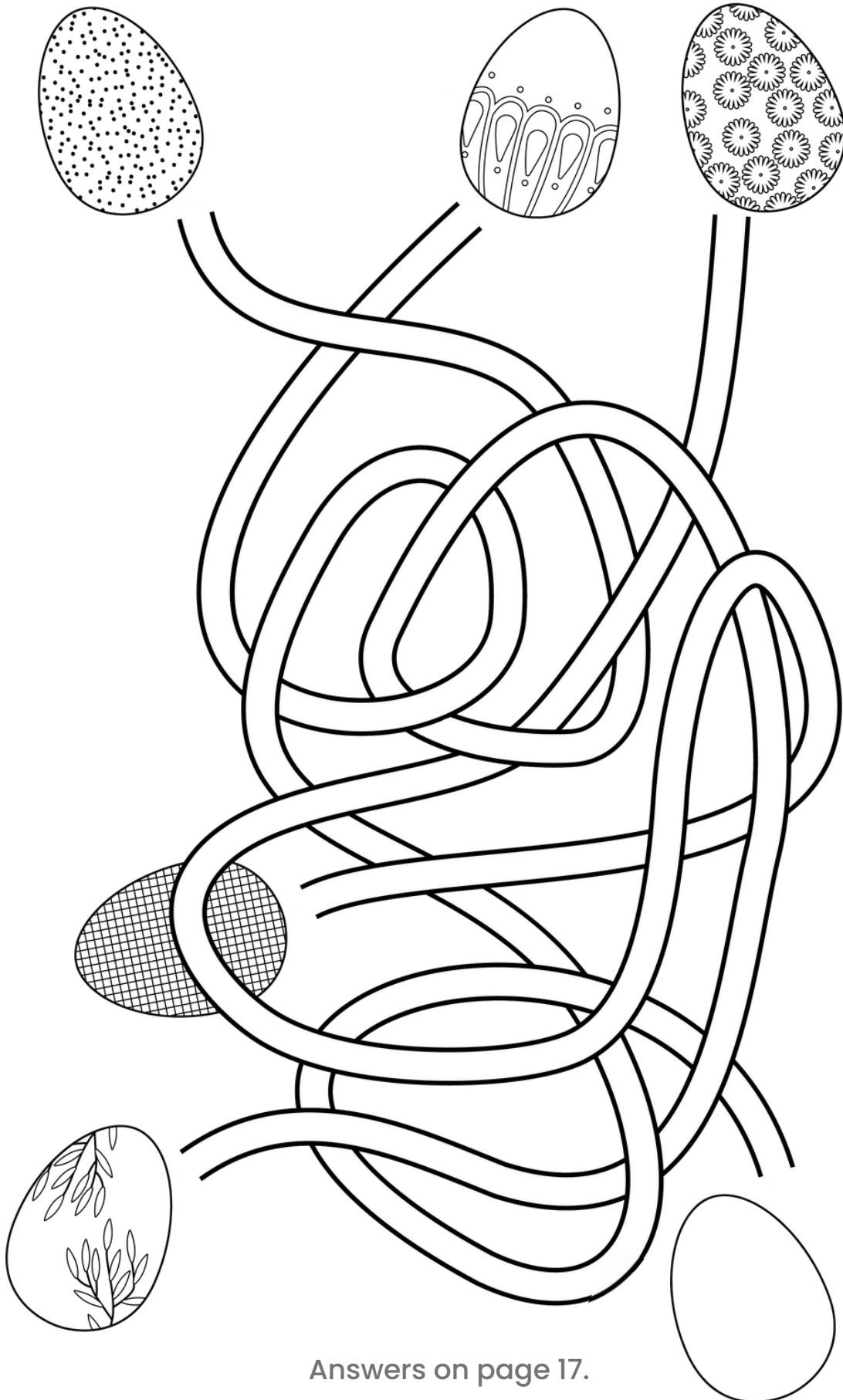
COLOUR IN THE EASTER EGG

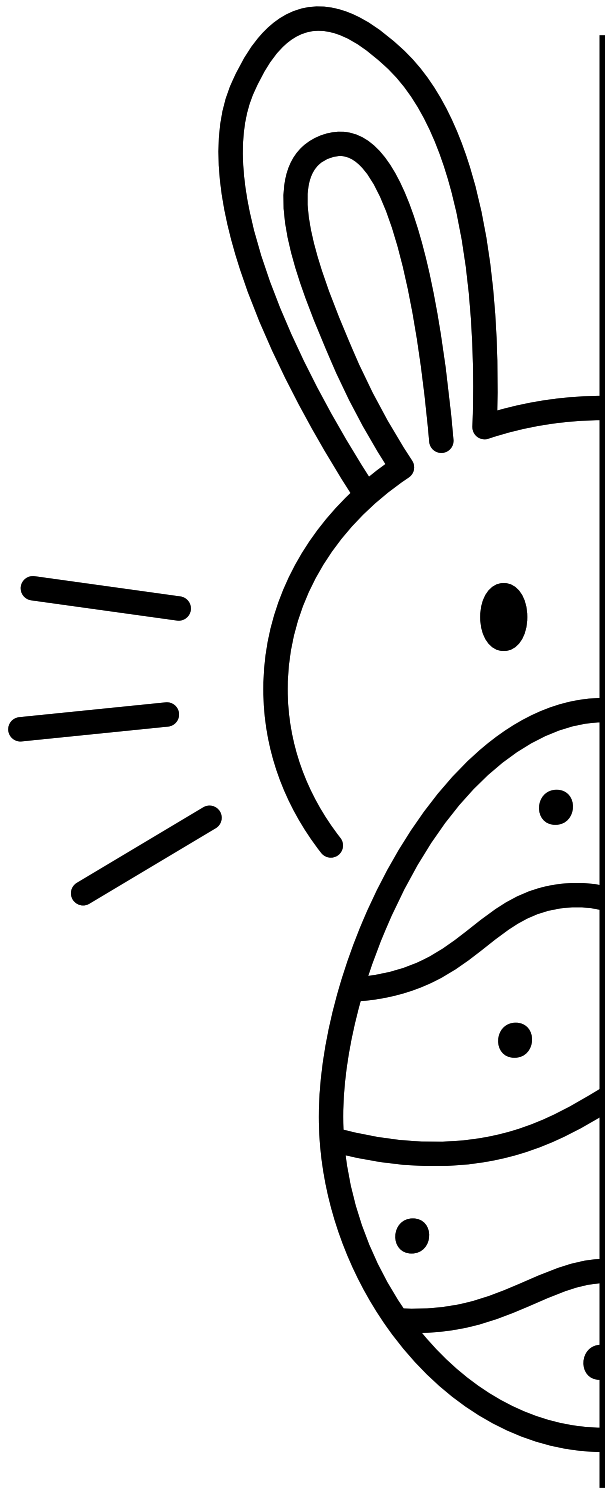

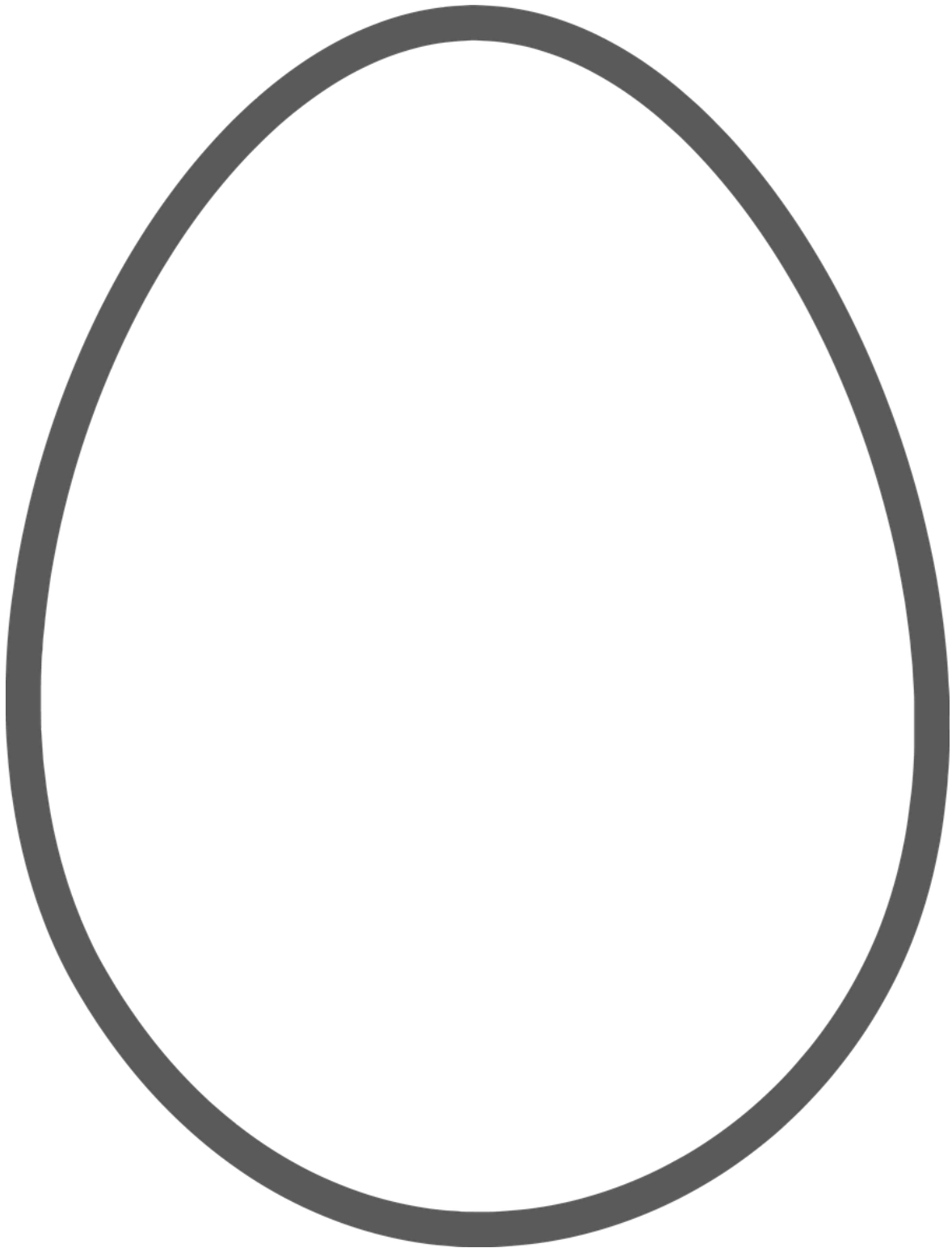


EASTER BUNNY AND EGG SYMMETRY DRAWING



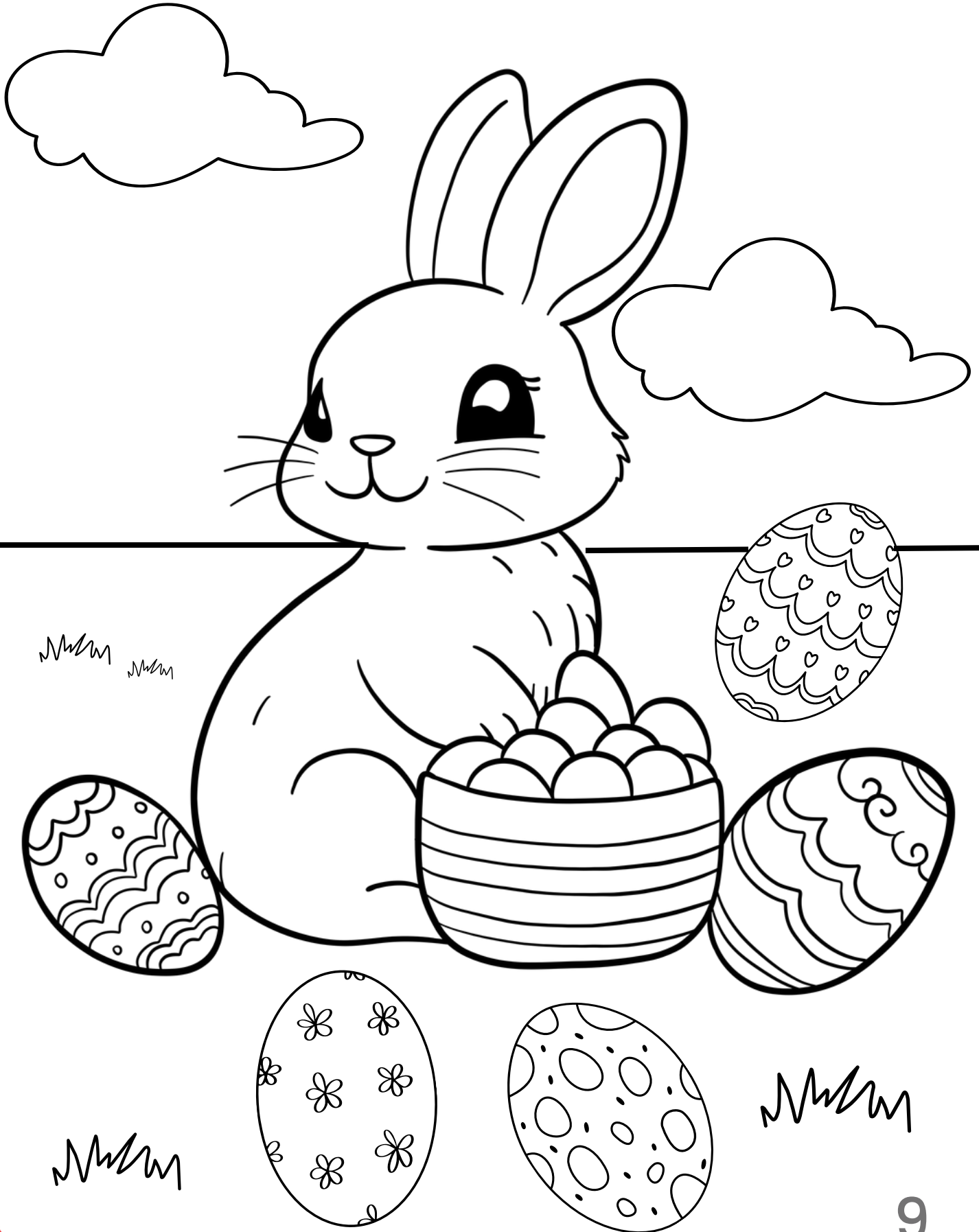

MARBLED DECORATIVE EGGS



MATERIALS NEEDED

- Fresh white eggs
- Disposable roasting tin
- 1 can of shaving foam
- Food colouring gels in various colours
- Skewer or toothpick
- Kitchen paper

3 STEPS

1. With the help of an adult, empty the eggs of their yolks and whites (use the egg-blowing technique), then wash and leave to dry.
2. Cover the base of the roasting tin with shaving foam. Sprinkle over drops of food colouring gels in your chosen colours and use a skewer or toothpick to marble the colourings into the foam slightly. Bright neon food colourings produce a stronger end result, while pastel colourings result in more delicate patterns.
3. Roll each eggshell all over in the foam, place on kitchen paper and leave for 20 mins. Wipe off all the foam and use to decorate as desired.

PIN THE TAIL ON THE BUNNY



MATERIALS NEEDED

- Pin the Tail on the Bunny Template (see on next page)
- Coloured paper
- Scissors
- Pom Poms in coordinating colors
- Velcro
- Hot Glue Gun (optional)
- Laminator



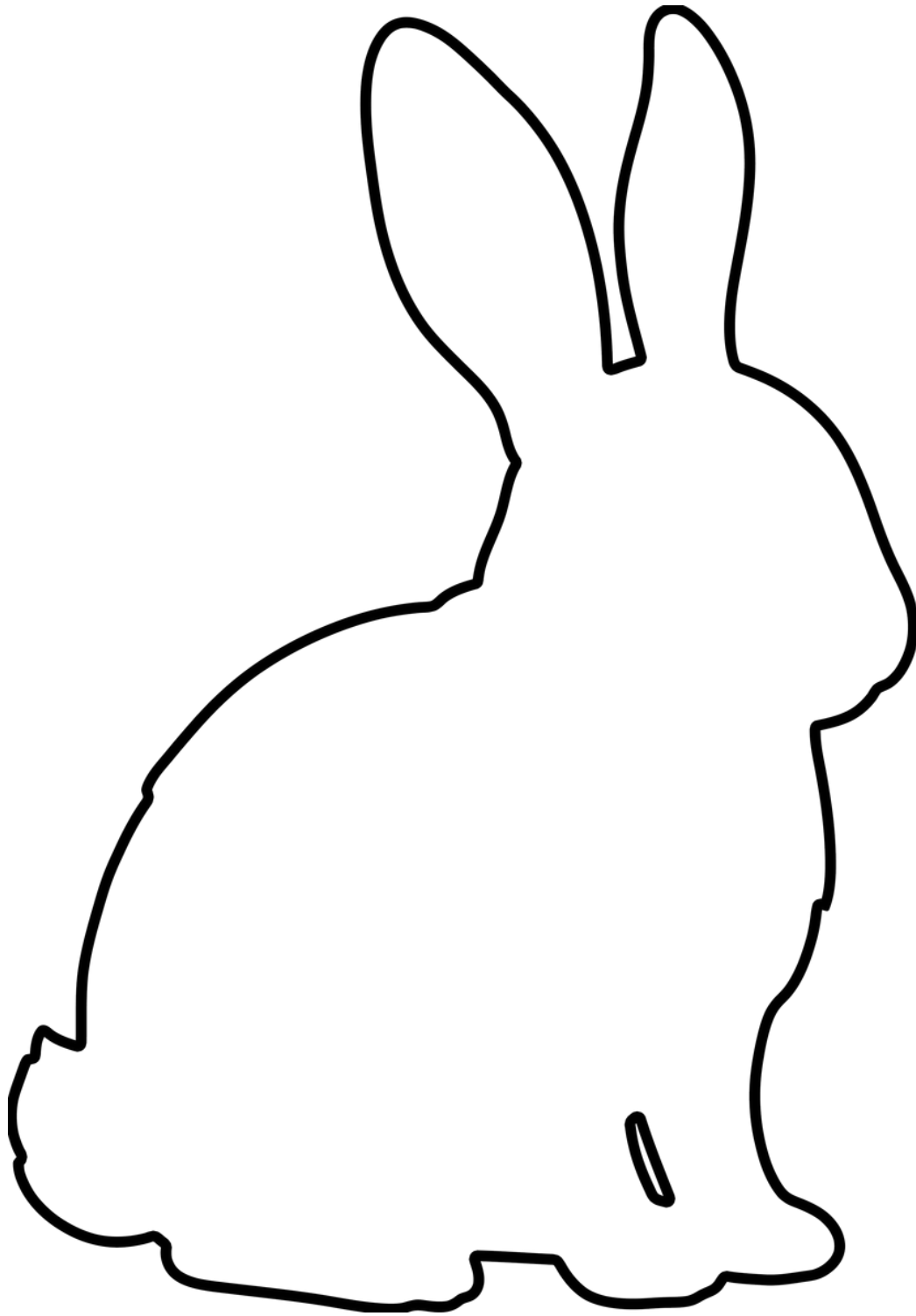

5 METHOD STEPS

1. With the help of an adult using the template to trace the bunny onto coloured pieces of paper.
2. Cut out the traced bunnies and laminate them.
3. Add Velcro to these bunnies and the pom poms.
4. Using the glue gun, add one side of your Velcro to the bottom of each bunny, making sure that whether you're using the hook side of the Velcro on the bunnies or the loop, you're using the same side for all of the bunnies and the opposite for the pom poms.
5. Now you're ready to match the pom pom tails to the bunnies!

PAPER CUP BUNNY

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Brown paper cup
- Hole puncher
- Twine
- Two big beads
- Brown paper
- Googly eyes (optional)
- Pink pom-pom (optional)
- Scissor
- Glue stick
- Black marker

7 METHOD STEPS

1. Gather the craft supplies above to create your paper cup bunny craft.
2. Start with your brown paper cup and turn it over, bottom (closed) side up. The top part of the cup will be the bunny's head and the bottom part is where we will attach the legs.
3. Take a hole puncher and make two holes on the bottom part of the paper cup, about 4 CM spaced out.
4. Cut a piece of twine, from about 25 CM. We're going to attach the two beads for the bunnies' feed. First, make a knot on one side of your string and attach a big bead to the end so it doesn't slip off. Poke your string through both holes of the paper cup and attached the other bead.
5. Cut two long ears from brown paper for your paper cup bunny. The ears can be as long as the cup, attach the ears to the top of the cup.
6. Now give your paper cup bunny two googly eyes or draw the eyes with a black paint marker.
7. Give your bunny a pom-pom nose or draw the nose with a marker and you're done!

YARN EASTER EGGS

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Water Balloons
- Yarn & Scissors
- Glue (general purpose)
- Newspaper for your work surface
- Bowl for your glue mix – something disposable is easiest!

STEPS

1. With the help of an adult, Blow up your water balloons, and cut some 2m lengths of yarn.
2. Mix 2 parts glue to 1 part water. 6 eggs, uses around 100ml. glue. Do this in a disposable bowl if you can.
3. Dip a strand of yarn into the bowl. Soak it completely, and then pull it out of the bowl, squeezing the excess from the yarn as you go.
4. Now, start wrapping your egg taking care to tuck the beginning and end of the yarn under your other wraps to secure it. Each egg uses approximately 3 strands.
5. Allow time to dry.
6. When the egg feels firm and dry remove the balloon by cutting a small hole in the balloon. Pull the deflated balloon out through one of the holes in the egg.



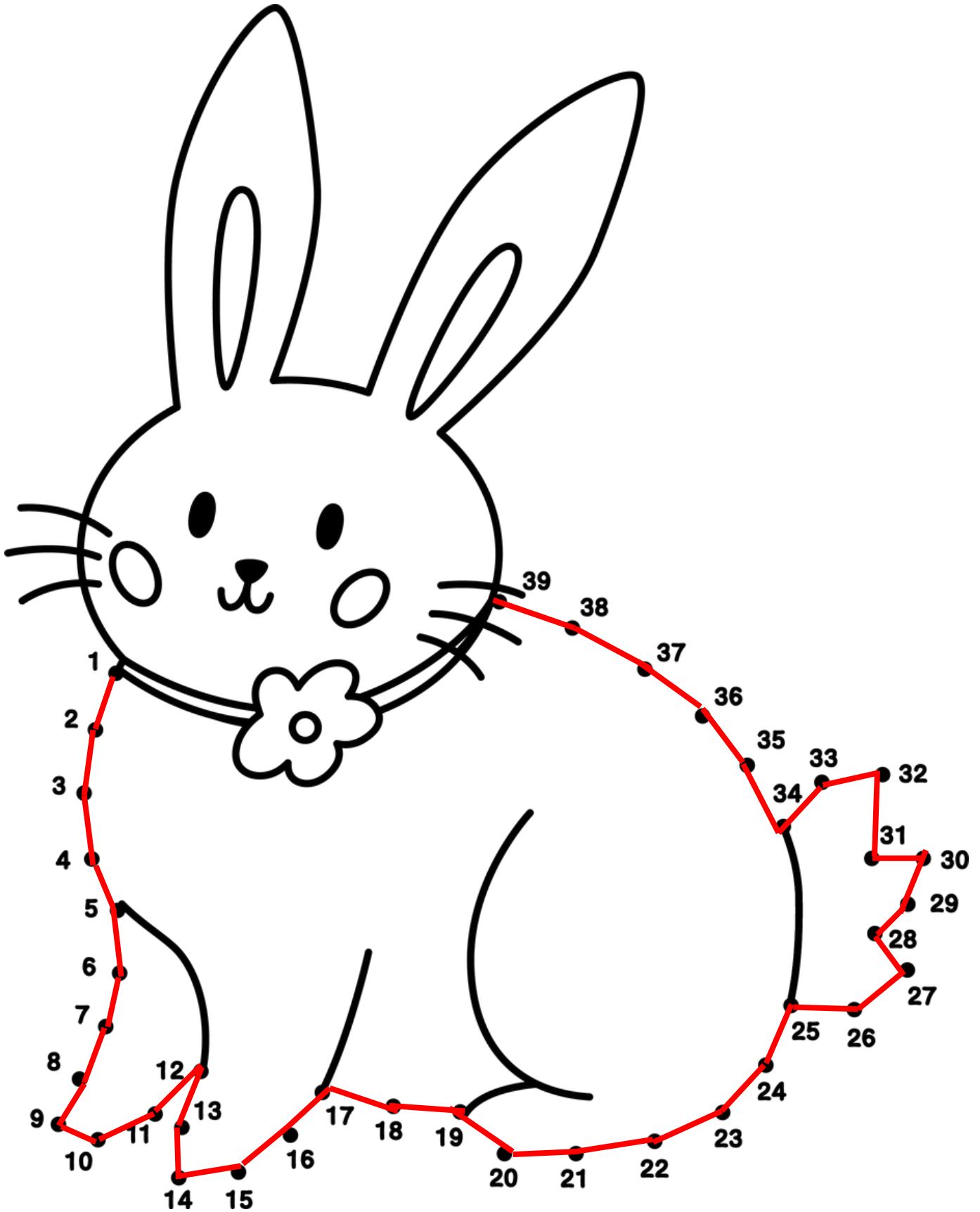
